The notification of acceptance of the abstracts will be sent to the authors/presenters through email by December 10, 2017.

Full Paper

Full paper must not exceed 3000 words. The references must be cited as per APA style. The Font is Times New Roman and the Font Size of the paper is as follows -

Title : Font size 14
Abstract and Key Words : Font Size 10
Full Texts : Font Size 12

The full-length paper should be mailed to conferenceseminarsocewu@gmail.com on or before March 20, 2018. In case of multiple authors, there must be an intimation regarding the paper presenter since only one presenter is entitled to present a paper.
